\$8 split **DOMAINE LAURIER BRUT, NAPA VALLEY, NV** Traditional methode champenoise creates fruit, depth and complexity built from the Chardonnay grape.

\$48 **SCHRAMSBERG BLANC DE BLANCS, CALISTOGA, 2006** Layered with flavors of citrus, ripe Anjou pear, dried pineapple and baked apple pie. This Chardonnay sparkler finishes with lingering and balanced acidity.

\$53 **SCHARFENBERGER BRUT, ANDERSEN VALLEY, NV** Delightful cherry and plum nose with hints of lychee and mango. Complex flavors of vanilla cream, caramel and hazelnut.

\$80 **RICHARD GRANT ESTATE BLANC DE NOIR, NAPA VALLEY, 2001** Rich apple-like fruit is enhanced with sentous undertones of citrus, making it crisp and refreshing with a delicate finish of brioche.

White

\$8/ 23 **ROBERT HALL ORANGE MUSCAT, PASO ROBLES, 2009** Entertains the senses with fresh citrus and orange blossoms on the nose. A touch of sweet ginger spice echoed by bright, tropical fruit rounds out the palate.

\$9/ 28 **VENTANA ESTATES REISLING, ARROYO SECO, 2009** Off dry style with a floral bouquet of orange blossom and roses. A palate of apricots and peaches makes for a deliciously long finish.

\$10/ 30 **PATIANNA VINEYARDS SAUVIGNON BLANC, MENDECINO COUNTY, 2008** Dry and crisp with flavors of berries, currants, myer lemons and geraniums, finishes with a slight minerality.

\$10/ 30 **ROBERT HALL VIOGNER, PASO ROBLES, 2008** Medium-bodied and refreshingly dry with a crisp acidity featuring honeysuckle, orange blossom and sweet spice.

\$11/ 32 **TANGENT PINOT GRIS, EDNA VALLEY, 2007** Full-bodied, with concentrated flavors of peach, ginger and tropical fruits. Framed by a light lemony acidity and a vibrant minerality.

\$8/ 32 **VENTANA ESTATES CHARDONNAY, ARROYO SECO, 2008** Lively tropical aromas of pineapple and mango, notes of pear, lemon and a light vanilla finish create a beautifully balanced wine.

\$13/ 40 **BELL WINE CELLARS CHARDONNAY, NAPA VALLEY, 2008** Bright and crisp vanilla aromas, with sweet oak flavors and a subtle cream texture a long finish and delightful mouth feel.

\$26 **ELIZABETH ROSE ROSÉ, YOUNTVILLE, 2008** A crisp and refreshing wine with lively acidity, complex flavors vary from strawberry and raspberry chutney to a peppery cinnamon spice.

\$56 **GUNDLACH & BUNDSCHU GEWÜRZTRAMINER, SONOMA VALLEY, 2006** Ripe, round fruit flavors of white pear, lychee, tangerine and kumquat are lifted by the bright, focused structure into a lingering spicy finish.

\$45 **TREFETHEN DRY RIESLING, NAPA VALLEY, 2007** Delicate aromas of guava, tarragon and jasmine flower. Great aperitif wine with deep, well balanced flavors.

\$32 **RAYMOND RESERVE SAUVIGNON BLANC, NAPA VALLEY, 2007** Refreshingly bright and lively with balanced acidity and a rich, full mouth feel. Opening aromas of grapefruit give way to floral honeysuckle with a smooth finish touched by honey and vanilla.

\$36 **J LOHR SAUVIGNON BLANC, NAPA VALLEY, 2007** Complex aromas of grapefruit, dried flowers, gun flint and a faint herbaceous freshness. On the palate, the wine has excellent weight and bright acidity with clean fruit flavors.

\$48 **LADERA VINEYARDS SAUVIGNON BLANC, HOWELL MOUNTAIN, 2007** A bright quenching wine with hints of kiwi, tangerine and green apple. delightful body with a slight minerality, crisp acidity but a clean floral finish.

\$79 **HARTFORD COURT CHARDONNAY, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, 2005** Complex flavors of white peach, citrus blossom, Asian pear and candied lemon give way to a rich and weighty mid-palate, followed by a long, exotic, spice infused finish.

\$84 **FOPPOLI CHARDONNAY, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, 2007** Premium oakless chardonnay promoting the true characteristics of the grape. Kiwi, green apple, pineapple, and grapefruit flavors abound.

Red

\$8/ 23 CARMENET VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR, SONOMA COUNTY, 2008 *Delicate and aromatic with depth and charm, hints of strawberries and spice finished with flavors of raspberry and cedar.*

\$10/ 30 J LOHR ESTATES MERLOT, PASO ROBLES, 2007 *Medium-bodied with firm and structured tannins, aromas of black cherry framed with a cedar-like oak complement the flavors of currant and cranberry.*

\$9/ 26 HARASZTHY FAMILY CELLARS OLD VINE ZINFANDEL, LODI, 2008 *Exceptionally rich and deep in color, aroma and flavor with hints of cherries, raspberries, and blackberries.*

\$13/ 25 carafe DONELAN BARREL SAMPLE SYRAH, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, 2008 *Not your parent's boxed wine! A delightful nose of blueberries with rich fruit flavor, slightly spicy with a long, lush finish to round out this rare offering.*

\$9/ 27 LAURIER CABERNET SAUVIGNON, ALEXANDER VALLEY, 2008 *Embraces the palate with soft acidity and silky tannins with layers of flavor from black cherry, plum, olive, and vanilla.*

\$40 RANCHO SISQUOC PINOT NOIR, SANTA BARBARA, 2007 *Silky and full with a clean finish, a structured palate highlighted by raspberry cream and ripe cranberry framed by toasty oak with hints of cinnamon and nutmeg.*

\$72 ALMA ROSA PINOT NOIR, SANTA RITA HILLS, 2007 *Showcasing the dark, rich side of Pinot Noir, brimming with flavors of crushed berries and cherries finishing with a spicy, floral note.*

\$35 BARNARD GRIFFIN MERLOT, COLUMBIA VALLEY, 2006 *Excellent fruit concentration, depth and density, a nose of black cherry, tobacco, and caramel notes with ripe plum licorice and earthy qualities in the background.*

\$86 REYNOLDS FAMILY WINERY MERLOT, STAGS LEAP, 2004 *Elegant with a nose of plump blueberries and vanilla and a touch of dark cherries and a subtle smoky note, a beautiful Stags Leap silky texture.*

\$81 D'ARGENZIO ZINFANDEL, RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, 2004 *Medium bodied, smooth and slightly rich. With aromas of lavender and sweet oak finished with flavors of raspberry, vanilla and maple.*

\$33 BONTERRA CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MENDOCINO COUNTY, 2007 *Approachable, good structured wine with soft tannins lively acidity and subtle spice. Hints of cedar, vanilla and raspberry.*

\$53 DEERFIELD CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NORTH COAST, 2004 *Smooth and lush, with velvety black cherry, waves of warm spice, cedar and tobacco accents. Ripe and rich.*

\$60 CORISON CABERNET SAUVIGNON 375ml, NAPA VALLEY, 2003 *Powerful and elegant with luscious flavors of plum chutney and Bing cherries and complex undertones of white pepper and cocoa.*
